Eligibility

Entrepreneurs, farmers and aspirants looking for establishment of enterprise in food processing. Applicant should have sufficient professional skills of reading and writing English and Hindi.

Boarding and Lodging

Boarding and Lodging will be provided to the participants on payment bases (not included in the training fee). The Institute has a furnished guesthouse/ hostel with dining, recreation and medical facilities in the campus. No accommodation will be provided to family members or guests of the participants.

Travel

Participants have to make their own arrangements and pay charges for travelling to ICAR-CIAE, Bhopal and back.

How to Reach CIAE

Bhopal is well connected by air, rail and road. Auto rickshaw and taxis can be availed from all points to reach ICAR-CIAE Bhopal campus (Prepaid, OLA, UBER). The Institute campus is located on Berasia Road and is 7 km from Bhopal Railway Station, 9 km from Raja Bhoj Airport (Bhopal) and 15 km from Inter State Bus Terminus.
